Dear Miss Rundle,

You will be interested to hear that an answer has been received from the Commonwealth Fund asking for further information about the scholarships applied for by the Council of Bedford College. This letter required an immediate answer and was put before the Joint Committee of Bedford College and the College of Nursing who drew up conditions of award of the scholarships and other information asked for. These conditions, of which I enclose a copy, were dispatched at once, together with the agreed syllabus, on the authority of my Chairman to the Commonwealth Fund.

In answer to your letter of December 16th you will note from the cover of the enclosed syllabus in what way it is proposed to signify that the College of Nursing is in co-operation with Bedford College in this course. My Council trust that the wording will meet with the approval of the

College of Nursing.

With regard to your question about the Certificate,
I am to say that that will be considered later when the
form of certificate is being drafted.
