I am preparing a new copy of the Prospectus for use during the interim period until the Florence Nightingale International Foundation is created. I am getting it out in the name of the Provisional Committee and am shortening it as much as possible as more changes will certainly have to be made in it when once the Foundation is established.

Would you be so kind as to let know what changes have been made in the curriculum and also let me have the new outlines for each subject if the lecturers wish any changes made in the outline as it now appears in the printed prospectus.
