REPORT of Practical Work in Public Health

Jan. to June 1933

During the Easter Vacation, Practical Work was arranged for the foreign students in country districts. Some were with Queen's nurses doing combined work, others with county Health Visitors vovering a larger area, others again were chiefly with the Superintendent of the Assistant Superintendent of a County Organization seeing their work. We had considerable help from our old Students in arranging this - Miss Gough, Miss Crothers and Miss Merry all kindly undertaking to assist us.

The five students who are taking the Health Visitors' examination spent four weeks doing Health Visiting work either in a London Borough or with the Surrey County Health Visitors. I think the four weeks at Easter is the most valuable time we have for practical experience, as the students can be out of London; also they are sufficiently versed in English conditions and language to make the most of the opportunity.

This term the students are writing a paper on some aspect of the work which they have selected themselves and I am able to arrange for them to visit institutions and interview people who can help them practically with the subject.

The group have worked well and the nurses and superintendents frequently tell me that they enjoy helping them and find their interest and enthusiasm a real encouragement. Attached is a detailed programme of their work since my last report.
