Dear Miss Haydon,

I am returning the industrial nursing account, which we received yesterday, as I find it is not correct. The industrial nursing students usually take, in addition to the three courses which you have calculated for, Elementary Economics for which I understand there will be another four guineas per student, and Psychology of the Adolescent (one term) which is £1. 11. 6. per student.

I am wondering if it would be possible for us to have an inter-collegiate fee for the industrial nursing students, as we do for those taking the health visitors' training.

I also enclose the account for the lectures attended at Bedford College by the health visitor students, as Miss Westgarth has now withdrawn from the course which will necessitate an alteration in the account.
