Report on the Practical Work of Students.

Six of the twelve Public Health Students spent August in the Maternity and Child Welfare Department of the Battersea Borough Council. Here they saw the routine work of the Health Visitors and made home visits with them. They attended the Clinics and classes and studied records and reports. During this time they had half-an-hour daily in class when the work of the Department was explained.

In September, these Students went to other organisations in the same district - the Tuberculosis Dispensary, the School Nursing & Care Committee, and the Charity Organisation Society. Here, those whose English was sufficiently good, did some independent visiting.

Individual arrangements were made for special Students. Miss Hamilton saw work in Surrey, Birmingham and in France. Miss Yinj and Miss Chu spent three weeks in the Battersea Borough Maternity Home and in September did Maternity and Child Welfare work in the Salomon Centre. Miss Dass, Miss Vogel, and Miss Leitin have all had a month in the Battersea Teaching district.

The Students have shown keen interest wherever they have worked and have added to the interest of the work of the Department.
