Dear Miss Rundle,

At the last meeting of the Committee for the Organisation of Courses for International Students the question of co-operation with the College of Nursing in connection with courses for English Nurses was considered in some detail and I am directed to send to you the following resolutions which were passed by the Council of Bedford College at their meeting on Wednesday last:-

"That a committee be appointed to consider what courses could be arranged by Bedford College in co-operation with the College of Nursing for English Nurses.

That the committee be constituted as follows:-  
The Principal of Bedford College ex officio  
4 members appointed by Bedford College  
4 members appointed by the College of Nursing.

That the College of Nursing be asked to appoint four representatives on this Committee."

It was proposed that the first meeting of this Committee should take place early in October next and I shall be glad to receive the names of the College of Nursing representatives not later than the 1st October.
