- 1. Examinations. There should be no difficulty in examining your students between 2nd and 4th June.
- 2. Period of Grant. In making their application for grant to their LEA's, the students will have to have included information about the dates of terms. Students should write to their LEA's to check this and should ensure that their grant will cover the clinical training period.

If so, the students should ask the Warden if they can transfer to Lindsell Hall or Rachel Notcutt Hall for the period in question.

Applications are invited for the following Fellowships, Studentships and Scholarships for Medical and Scientific Research.

1. Hazel Clifford Postgraduate Studentship for postgraduate research in medicine or on a scientific topic concerned with the advancement of medical knowledge. Value: £2,770, for one year in the first instance tenable at a School of the University of London.
2. Williams Fellowship for Medical and Scientific Research for original research into the cause and cure of diseases affecting human beings. Value: £2,999 plus an allowance for research and other expenses, tenable for two academic sessions at a School of the University of London.
3. Carlo Campolin Postgraduate Scholarship for research in Astronomy or in Biology. Value: approximately £300 a year for one year in the first instance, tenable at a School or Institute of the University of London.
4. Keddey-Fletcher Warr Studentship for research in the Faculty of Science. Value: £1,000 per annum tenable for two academic sessions at a School of the University of London.

Note: Nos 1 and 2 above are open to graduates of the University of London who are either registered medical practitioners or possess other appropriate qualifications. Nos 3 and 4 are open to graduates of any University possessing appropriate qualifications.

Application forms and further particulars may be obtained from the Secretary to the Scholarships Committee, University of London, Senate House, London WC1E 7HU to whom completed forms must be returned not later than 1 March 1982.

MEMORANDUM

To: Registrar

We have now worked out our plans for the vacation training of our nursing studies students. You will remember, that our nursing studies students undertake clinical experience concurrently with their academic study during the session and then, after the examinations have been concluded they undergo full-time clinical training for the rest of the term and for such a period into the vacation as is necessary for them to have completed a requisite number of hours. I would like to have your agreement to the following:

- (1) that our students are examined during that period which exists before the main examinations begin on the 7th June. They have three papers and I would like to have these on the 2nd to the 4th June.
- (2) I would like the students to have full-time clinical training for seven weeks from the 7th June to the 25th July.
- (3) What arrangements do we have to make to ensure that the students have their grant extended to cover this period?
- (4) May I raise the problem of residence. All of the students, now seven in number, are I believe in College halls of residence. What action would you like me to take?
