Four students only are taking the Course for Nurse Administrators and Teachers in Schools of Nursing this year. These students represent :-

Iceland, Norway, Poland, Great Britain.

They spent their first six weeks in hospital, studying training school administration in

Guy's Hospital, King's College Hospital, St. Thomas's Hospital,

and, as last year, returned to Manchester Square each weekend.

They are now attending lectures at the College of Nursing on Training School and Hospital Administration. Coaching classes have been arranged for them in two groups each Tuesday afternoon.
