

Report of Practical Work - Public Health Students

August - October 1938

Four students chose the Public Health Course this year. Two Indians, the Polish Student and Miss Ellerker. Miss Ellerker and Miss Korah wish to prepare themselves for the Health Visitors Examination next July.

Mrs. Pillay, from Nagpur, India, has had six weeks practical observation in various health centres, but has been advised by our Doctor to return home as he does not think she will stand the English winter. She has therefore decided to withdraw from the Course and will be returning to India on October 28th.

Miss Ellerker and Miss Korah each had three weeks work with the Health Visitors in the Marylebone Borough. After this Miss Korah went to Surrey to see the county work and was attached to one of the Surrey County Health Visitors in Redhill and district for three weeks. Miss Ellerker was at an Infant Welfare Centre and did the work of a Health Visitor under supervision.

Miss Batycka spent the six weeks at a Settlement in Fulham where she was attached to the School Care Committee and to the Child Welfare work. Her English is not good but has improved very much in the last four weeks and she is continuing to take English lessons.

We have one student this year, Miss Hakola, who has selected the course in Family Case work. She spent five weeks in the United Girls School Settlement in Peckham and is now attached to the Paddington Office of the Charity Organisation Society where she will be working for two days a week this term.
