The Duchess of Kent has promised to visit the Red Cross international bazaar during the afternoon of July 7. The bazaar, which is in aid of the Florence Nightingale International Foundation, is to be held on July 7 and 8 at Central Hall, Westminster, instead of at Bedford College for Women. The Lady Mayoress will open the bazaar at noon on the first day.

The Florence Nightingale International Foundation awards scholarships in foreign countries and the British Empire entitling the holders to attend advanced courses of instruction in nursing in London, and there are generally 16-20 students who come for a year

a year.
So far 36 countries have sent gifts to furnish stalls, which will be presided over by their respective diplomatic representatives in London.
