Scheme II

As a large proportion of the total under this scheme is a fixed payment - £84. 0. 0 it is obvious that this scheme would work out more cheaply for a greater number of students.

Scheme III on the other hand has a small proportion of its total fixed - £21. 0. 0 and will therefore be more expensive for a greater number of students in comparison with Scheme II.
