Dear Principal,

We have been asked by the Spanish and Hungarian Red Cross Societies if the Summer School will be only for past students of the courses, or if they will be permitted to send other Red Cross Nurses to follow the lectures. We have considered the question here, and feel that it might be advisable to admit a limited number of nurses sent by Red Cross Societies to the lectures and discussions if this would be a means of getting Red Cross Societies interested. We feel, however, that residence at Bedford College should be reserved for the past students only, and other nurses be found accommodation elsewhere. Would you be so kind as to bring this question up at your next committee meeting and let me know what the members feel with regard to it. We are rather anxious not to have an overwhelming number of outside students.
