
Nurse Administrators' Course for International Students

The question of the fees due to the College of Nursing in connection with the above course were considered by the Council of Bedford College at their meeting yesterday. I am now instructed to convey to you the resolution of my Council that one-third of the fees (viz., £15.15. 0) received from the League of Red Cross Societies on behalf of those students taking the Nurse Administrator Course be paid to the College of Nursing.
