

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS. HOSPITAL GROUP.MICHAELMAS TERM. 1930.

During the Michaelmas Term the nine students taking the Hospital Administration Course attended lectures in Hospital and Training School Administration at the College of Nursing, and visits of observation to illustrate these lectures were arranged to special Hospitals and Homes.

Three ^{sets of questions} ~~test~~ papers, based on the Hospital Administration lectures, had been set by Mr. Orde during the term, and he had expressed satisfaction at the high standard of the papers, and the understanding and originality shewn in the answers.

The students are now occupied with a question set by Miss Musson, dealing with Training School Administration, by which it is hoped to gain some knowledge of the extent of their understanding of English training school methods.

No practical work was arranged during the Christmas vacation, but arrangements are being made for the students to visit and reside in various hospitals for a part of the Easter vacation.

During this term the students are continuing lectures at the College of Nursing on Hospital and Training School Administration, and also attending lectures on Educational Psychology and Methods of Teaching, History of Nursing and Nutrition.

Coaching Classes are being continued during the term on alternate Tuesdays and Fridays, the students being again divided into three groups in order to provide individual tuition.
