

Report of Practical Work.

Public Health Group.

The Public Health Students have had one day's work per week during the last term mainly in the Lambeth Borough. & we are indebted to the Medical Officer of Health - to St. Thomas's Hospital & to the local Infant Welfare Centres for their help in giving the students this experience.

Since last Committee I have visited the Birmingham Public Health Dept. - the East Sussex County Nursing Federation & the Hertfordshire County Nursing Assoc<sup>n</sup> with a view to arranging practical experience for the students. The P.C.H

of Birmingham - Dr. Neusholme - is very sympathetic & willing to continue his help in taking occasional students to see the work, particularly in the Fraternity & Child Welfare Dept. Four of the Internationals spent a week there during the Christmas vacation & found the visit most profitable.

East Sussex Federation have arranged work for the students for the last five years & feel that they cannot at present undertake further responsibility.

The Superintendent of the Hertfordshire County Nursing Federation has undertaken to arrange for 3 or 4 students to be placed with her nurses in rural parts of the County during April in order that they may see the public health work

done by them there I will herself explain to them the organization of the work & the supervision of nurses & midwives in the county.

Further rural work will have to be found for the students & I propose to approach the Surrey County Council with a view to placing some of the students with their county Health Visitors.
