**Re: Bedford College/Middlesex Hospital
 Nursing Students Final Year 1985/86**

I am writing to you in relation to the programme of this course which, as you know, is being phased out at the end of this Academic Year.

We had hoped to see you at the finalist party of the previous graduates which was a jolly affair and I am very pleased to tell you that all five of them have settled well into their new posts and are looking forward towards their professional development.

As you know, because of Bedford College's merger with Royal Holloway College and at Egham it was impossible to continue this course and as a result Mrs. Meerabeau left the course prematurely in the development of her own further career. To help us out with problems of practical supervision and the organising of clinical placements for the last year we were fortunate to obtain the services of Mr. Nazeer on a part-time basis and he and I will share supervision at the academic and clinical level. The course is now situated at 11 Bedford Square where most of the teaching will take place and if anything we are now closer to the Middlesex Hospital than we were before.

As I, Mr. Nazeer and the students shall need a common reference point near where the students are working so that messages can be passed easily to and fro and the odd discussion can take place, I request that the department be able to claim Mrs. Meerabeau's now vacated desk for just this one year so that Middlesex's part of responsibilities towards this course can be retained until the course finishes July 26th 1986.
