Dear Dame Alicia,

Your letter about the International Students being members of the Union was before the Council at their meeting last week. The Council feel very strongly that these Students should be able, when possible, to take advantage of the privileges offered by the Union, though they quite understand that their programme leaves them little time for such matters. They therefore decided to allow the composition fee of £50 paid on behalf of each Student to include membership of the Students' Union, and passed the following resolution:

"That in future the composition fee of £50 charged to the Florence Nightingale International Foundation students include membership of the Students' Union."
