

Report of Practical Work Arranged for International  
Students. August - October 1936.

---

Five students have selected Public Health Nursing and one Social Work. I have a copy of the detailed programme arranged for each students, for the information of the Committee.

With the exception of Miss de Klerk, who came late, each Public Health Student has had at least two weeks' observation in a London Borough Health Department, and two weeks in a rural area. The other two weeks were planned to suit the individual student.

I am particularly pleased with the result of sending students for the last two years to Marylebone Health Department. Dr. Porter allows me to make individual arrangements with his senior Health Visitors there, and they, besides being very well qualified and excellent visitors, are interested to show their work. They have planned to show our students everything.

The County Nursing Federation in East Sussex and one of the Regional Superintendents of the Surrey County Council have arranged the rural work this year.

Miss Gadd has selected the Social Work Course - (it is called Family Case Work in the new curriculum A 2). This means she has to do eleven weeks' practical soacial work before going on to the C.O.S. and here she has to do at least 15 weeks or 75 days. She has completed six of the eleven introductory weeks at St. Hilda's East Settlement, Bethnal Green. The ICAA work was not very successful as their office was too short handed, but the Warden of the Settlement has been able to arrange some careful tuition for her in their School Care Committee Office.

I think it will be difficult for Miss Gadd to become proficient enough in her home visiting and reporting to gain acceptance into a C.O.S. office; but I hope that this may be possible by Christmas. She is intelligent and persistent, and has improved very much in these six weeks.
