REPORT OF PRACTICAL PUBLIC HEALTH WORK - EASTER VACATION 1931

During the vacation three weeks were spent in practical work outside London.

Miss Crothers was in East Sussex with the County Nursing Federation and studied the organization of the work and the supervision of the nurses and midwives. The other two English Students were attached to Health Visitors in Surrey and worked under them, doing the ordinary work of a Health Visitor in a country area.

The Superintendent of the ^{Surrey} ~~Sussex~~ County kindly arranged observation for Miss Thomas and Miss Fussenegger, and they visited rural welfare centres and schools and saw the organization and work of the county. Miss Thomas also spent a week in Buckinghamshire with Miss Watt, an Old International Student now doing Health Visiting in that county.

The Public Health Students have now completed their practical work in England with the exception of Miss Merry who started late. Miss Thomas and Miss Fussenegger are planning to spend two weeks on their return journey seeing work in Europe, which will be planned for them by Mrs. Carter.

All the Students have worked well and shown keen interest and observation. They have written good and thoughtful reports of the work they have seen, and I have had good reports of them from everyone concerned.
