Dear Miss Rundle,

I must apologise for not writing before in answer to your letter of the 24th October. In this connection I now write to say that my Council have agreed to accept your proposals for the next three years and the following resolutions were passed at their meeting on October 30th:-

"That Bedford College pay to the College of Nursing a subsidy of 20 guineas per annum towards the cost of special courses arranged for Bedford College International Students."

" That in addition to this subsidy payments be made to the College of Nursing for courses attended by Bedford College students at the ordinary College of Nursing rates less one seventh."

"That in the case of College of Nursing students attending courses at Bedford College the ordinary Intercollegiate rates be allowed."
