

Translation from the French.

Extract from the letter from the President of the Yugoslavian Red Cross Society in reply to the letter of the Secretary General of the League informing him of the decision of the Organization Committee to postpone the admission of the two Yugoslavian candidates until October, pending a report on their practical work.

".....Your last letter causes some confusion. It appears to us that your doubts concerning the age and previous education are not altogether justified. Our candidates, besides having had four years of study at the "Lycée", are graduates of our School of Nursing in which, besides the technical instruction of the nurse, special attention has been given to social and health legislation, etc. Our school of nursing is recognized by law as a special school and the nurses graduated from it have the same rights as those students graduated from the "Lycée".

Miss Smiljanic, having finished the School of Nursing, passed her examination for the diploma, after which she remained at the school as assistant sister tutor for the practical instruction and carried out this work with great success. Miss Cabrinovic spent a year in the Health Centre. Although young, both are mature and we are sure that they will follow the International Courses with success.

☒ We hope that the Organization Committee will be satisfied with the results of the preliminary practical work and will confirm their admission.

As to their lack of knowledge of the English language, it is well known that one learns the language more quickly in the country itself.

We will be very glad to learn that our candidates have been admitted to the International Courses in Public Health. In any case if it is not possible for some reason or other we will be satisfied with the decision of the committee"....."
