INTERNATIONAL PUBLIC HEALTH STUDENTS

Report of Practical Work - January - May 1930.

---

During the Easter Vacation three weeks were given to practical work. Two students had work arranged for them in Europe by the League of Red Cross Societies. Six students saw the work in the county districts of England - two in Hertfordshire, two in Surrey and two in Durham. Miss Kurrik went to the Childrens Hospital, Birmingham where she was placed mainly in the Out Patient Department, and also had several days with the Health Visitors in the Public Health Department of the City.

They have all written reports of the work they saw and I should like to take these into consideration in their examination of Public Health Nursing.

I am doubtful whether the usefulness of the Office in Kennington Road justifies the expense. I use it for lectures and coaching when the students are actually working in Lambeth but that is only during the first term of the year. For the rest of the year it is only used as an office for myself and for housing the various reports and materials I collect for coaching.

During the practical work periods, I could use my office at St. Thomas's Hospital which would be almost as convenient and I should be able, by the kind permission of Miss Lloyd Still, to use the nurses demonstration and class room for my lectures.
