Dear Miss Monkhouse,

I am instructed to write to you concerning certain matters which have been considered by the Committee of Management of this Foundation, and which they wish referred to Bedford College for consideration:-

1. The Committee of Management have nominated Dame Alicia Lloyd Still and Mrs. Carter to be their representatives on the Committee for the Organisation of Courses for International Students for the next two years, October 1937 to October 1939.

They also ask for a third representative on this Committee in order that Miss Isabel Stewart, Chairman of the Education Committee of the International Council of Nurses, may also represent them. Although her presence at the meetings cannot be frequent, owing to her residence in the U.S.A., my Committee feel that it is important that she should be kept informed of the work of the Committee, and be free to express her opinion on matters there arising.

2. The Committee of Management ask that the University of London be approached with a request that the International students be granted the status of "Associate Students of the

University", if they are eligible for such status.

3. The Committee of Management ask that to the Group A subjects in the syllabus be added a fourth subject, that of Principles of Education and Methods of Teaching; the subject ~~two~~ in Group B being retained.
