HYGIENE COURSE EXAMINERS.

Meeting of Thursday, July 17th 1913.

Resolved that under

Item 1.

If a student of the Hygiene Course has already passed one or more of the preliminary subjects for the diploma in the B. Sc. examination, or its equivalent, she may, subject to the approval of the teacher and the external examiner, be excused from sitting for the examination for the diploma in that subject.

But the student will not be excused from attending the course

of lectures and practical work of the subject.

It was resolved for the 1913 course

to excuse

Miss Preedy from the examination in Physics for the diploma

Miss Bradbury from the examination in Physics and Chemistry subject to her passing the B. Sc. examination in those subjects.

Item 2.

It was decided that the teachers and external examiners for the Hygiene diploma should meet regularly after each examination

and that for the purpose they be formed into a Board with
Mr. F. Womack as Chairman and
Mr. J.A.H. Brincker as Convener.
It will be the duty of the Chairman and Convener to arrange as follows:

(1) Dates of examination.

- (2) For the examination questions and papers to be sent for the approval of the external examiner.
- For the meeting of the examiners as soon after the examination as possible.
- (4) To report the decisions of the Board to the Principal.
