Dear Miss Rundle,

Your letter of the 1st July to the Principal was before the Council of Bedford College at their meeting on July 13th, and I am directed to say that my Council are quite prepared to agree with the suggestion of the College of Nursing and passed the following resolutions:-

1. "That Miss G.M. Bowes, a past student of Bedford College, who has recently taken the Hospital Administration Course and has been appointed by the College of Nursing as acting Education Officer for the session 1927-28, be appointed Tutor for the students taking the Nurse Administrators' Course, on the understanding that Miss Bowes gives half her time to her duties as Tutor and that Bedford College contributes half her salary out of the International grant for such purposes up to a sum not exceeding £200."
2. "That the Tutor for the students taking the Nurse Administrators Course be responsible for arranging the training on the practical side for all the students entering for the Nurse Administrators Course, such arrangements to include the practical work in hospitals and coaching of students."
