## Report of Public Practical Work of P.H. students

Easter vacation 1934.

During this period I usually try to obtain work for the P.H. students outside London - mainly in county areas. My object is, to give them a short period with a nurse working alone or with one or two others in a scattered area & also to give them some instruction in the head offices of the County Health Dept & the County Nursing Association in the organisation of the nursing work of the county, the supervision of nurses & midwives & the type of record system used.

This year we had 2 days in a group at Leamington where the County H.O. Dr. Fleg & Miss Wyatt the County Superintendent kindly arranged for us to see hear about the nursing work of the county & to spend a half day each with one of the county nurses.

Miss Britton then was then in Durham & in Shropshire studying the training of H.V.s & midwives.

Miss Brauer had 10 days in the H.C. N. Dept & the Ch. Hospital in Birmingham. The 3 Health Visitors worked <sup>one each</sup> in the P.H. Depts of Pav. Westminster & Surrey.

The 3 more junior students each had 10 days living & working with the county nurses.

Miss Vnick & Miss Kansanen both had 3 weeks T.C.A.A. work.

The reports of both Miss Vnick & Miss Kansanen's work in the T.C.A.A. offices are somewhat disturbing. Both secretaries report that they were unable to give them any but very simple visiting on account of language difficulty & both also ~~repor~~ felt that they were too easily satisfied with a superficial study of the work of the T.C.A.A. & did not ~~approach the work~~ study the work being done with care & judgment.

As this criticism comes at the end of their year with us, ~~it~~ & was the independent criticism of 2 secretaries of 2 different students, I feel that possibly it was more a ~~judgment~~ suggestion of a weakness in the course than necessarily in these 2 students.
