

21st January 1930Interview with Mrs. Reid re College of Nursing Business

1. That at the Academic Board a recommendation be put forward that in drawing up a syllabus for English Nurses authority be given to use the principles in the syllabus already sanctioned for the International Courses, i.e. arranged by Bedford College for Women in conjunction with the College of Nursing.
2. That the next meeting of the Nursing Committee be postponed until after the next meeting of the Academic Board as its main work at present is only to draw up the terms of the certificate to be given to English Nurses if the course materialises.
3. That the wording of the certificate, based on the Public Health Workers' Certificate, bringing in the College of Nursing, be drafted and given to Mrs. Reid for criticism as soon as possible.
4. A letter drafted by Dr. Barry Smith in conference with Mrs. Reid to be sent immediately with various enclosures.
5. Social Studies. Complaint from Mrs. Reid, Social Studies Department very cold and impossible for work purposes especially the class room and coaching room. She asked that something might be done about it immediately or all the students might get ill, some being accustomed to warm climates. This matter to be looked into and the temperature of the rooms to be taken with a thermometer.
