I write to acknowledge your letter to the Principal of July 26th, informing the Council of Bedford College of the arrangements made by the Committee of Management of the Florence Nightingale International Foundation in connection with the arrangements for the Courses for International Students for the session 1934-35.

I am further to say that the Council of Bedford College are, in accordance with the wish expressed by your Committee of Management, ^{arranging} to reconstitute the special Committee for the organisation of these Courses. I am to ask the Florence Nightingale International Foundation to be good enough to nominate two representatives of the Foundation to serve on this Committee, replacing the representatives of the League of Red Cross Societies.
