

Resolutions passed by Finance Committee

11th November 1938.

6. Recommendations from the Committee for the Organisation of Courses for International Students concerning payment of additional fees for outside courses.

Reported that the Committee for the Organisation of Courses for International Students had recommended that certain of the students should be allowed to take outside courses at other Colleges; that these courses would have to be paid for out of the composition fees received by Bedford College.

The Principal spoke to the question and stated that in her opinion the fees received for International students were fully adequate, and that any reasonable requests from the Organisation Committee for the payment of Intercollegiate fees should be met. She therefore supported the recommendations before the Committee.

RESOLVED that payment of Intercollegiate fees on behalf of the following International students be allowed:-
