Dear Miss Monkhouse,

I am sorry I shall be unable to attend the meeting on July 4th, but I cannot leave Paris so long.

I am enclosing the names of the candidates for next year's International Courses. Copies of the application forms, with medical and dental certificates have been sent to Miss Dorsey, and she will let you have them as soon as they arrive.

The application forms of three of the candidates have not yet arrived, but in each case we have been assured that the candidates meet the requirements, so I suggest that they are admitted provisionally, and then come up for confirmation at the meeting in October.

I have been rather worried as to the number of applications; they have been more than usual, and it is difficult to refuse people, but fortunately three have fallen out, and our number at present is twenty-six, which is as many as we can possibly manage to take.

The Commonwealth Fund has notified us that this is the last year they will be sending Austrian Students, so that next year we shall probably have no difficulty.

The standard this year seems to compare quite favourably with past years. It is certainly interesting to note that the number of scholarships given by Red Cross Societies and outside organizations has increased, and the League scholarships are less, showing the interest

of the Red Cross Societies in sending students at their own expense.
