re: Joint Undergraduate course in Nursing Studies  
with SRN Qualifications:  
Middlesex Hospital/Bedford College (London Univ.)

I am writing to you at the suggestion of Miss Cynthia Clamp,  
Senior Nurse Tutor at the Middlesex Hospital.

Since 1981, in conjunction with the Middlesex School of Nursing,  
we have been conducting a four-year undergraduate course in Nursing  
Studies. Our nursing students undergo their practical learning  
experience on wards in the Middlesex Hospital where they are supervised  
and partially tutored by its nurse-tutor staff.

The purpose of this letter is to place a request for obtaining  
five placements for Paediatric nursing. Our students spend  $2\frac{1}{2}$  days  
per week at ~~Bedford College, Regent's Park~~, and  $2\frac{1}{2}$  days per week on  
the wards at the Middlesex, of which one half-day is a study day.  
The period the paediatric placement is planned for is October/November/  
December 1983, and I would be most appreciative if we could find a way  
whereby our nursing students' paediatric learning experience could be  
assured.

This letter is meant as a preliminary introduction, and maybe  
I could follow it up with a personal meeting at a mutually convenient  
time.
