Dear Mrs. Carter,

Recommendations from the Organisation Committee were received by the Council at their meeting last week when I was directed to send to you the following resolutions which were then passed:-

- (1) "That International Students entering for the Hospital Administration Course who have had only a limited experience in Hospital work be required to come to England in the early summer in time to spend three months in an English Hospital Training School before entering on the Hospital Administration Course at Bedford College."
- (2) "That the existing arrangements for the organisation of courses for International Students be continued for the session 1929-30 provided that they can be continued under the same conditions, financially and otherwise, as for the last two years."
- (3) "That the whole question of the continuance of the organisation of courses for International Students after the close of the session 1929-30 be reconsidered at an early date."

With reference to the second of the above resolutions, I shall be glad to hear from you in due course

whether the League of Red Cross Societies are prepared
to continue their grant for the session 1929-30.
