Dear Miss Jebb,

We are making plans for our programme of lectures for next session and I write now to ask if it will be possible for a course of lectures to be given in Social Administration (Mrs. Reid) and Industrial Conditions (Mrs. Williams), arranged specially for our Public Health Students. I need hardly say how much we should appreciate this arrangement.

If this request is considered favourably, may I suggest that these special courses, which last session were given during the Summer term, should, next year, take place in the Lent term, thus enabling two groups of our students to attend together.

I would be glad to know if we could come to some arrangement whereby the College of Nursing paid a definite fee in respect of any courses of lectures arranged specially for its students, instead of a fee for each individual student attending as is the case with students attending lectures already in existence at Bedford College. For your information, may I state that our usual fee for a course of 10 lectures given at the College of Nursing is 20 guineas.

I would like to say how much the special lectures given by Mrs. Reid and Mrs. Williams during the present term have been appreciated by our students.
