Dear Miss Monkhouse,

I have to thank you for your letter of October 16th, in which you inform me that the Organisation Committee have interviewed Miss H. C. Parsons and has agreed to recommend to your Council Miss Parsons' appointment as Tutor to the Nurse Administrator Students, at Bedford College for the Session 1930 - 31.

I note that the appointment will be confirmed at your Council Meeting on October 30th.

Miss Parsons' salary will be £400 per annum. I will let you know immediately Miss Parsons takes up her duties.
