Dear Miss Parsons,

In accordance with the decision made at the Committee for the Organisation of Courses for International Students held on Tuesday last, Mrs. Reid has considered the question of testing the work of the students in "Educational Psychology" and has consulted Dr. Halsey in this matter. They suggest that the marking of the work should be based partly on the preparation for and giving of demonstration lessons, work which each student is asked to do during the term, partly on the criticisms that the students make on these lessons and partly from a personal interview which might be regarded as a viva voce test.

Dr. Halsey suggests that the viva voce test should be substituted for the written examination for which hitherto she has been responsible.

I am to ask you to be good enough to bring these suggestions before the Education Committee of the College of Nursing for their approval.
