Dear Mrs. Carter,

The Principal has asked me to send you the following resolution passed by the Council at their last meeting:-

"That no action be taken for the present with regard to inviting the British Red Cross Society to send a representative to serve on the Committee for the Organisation of Courses for International Students."

The reason for this resolution was that if the Committee was augmented by a representative of the British Red Cross the number of outside members on the Committee would then be equal to the number of Academic members and it was thought that on such a Committee the Academic side should predominate by at least one member. I am sorry I did not send you this resolution sooner.
