

COURSE FOR NURSE ADMINISTRATORS AND

TEACHERS IN SCHOOLS OF NURSING

Report on the practical work during the Christmas vacation.

Miss Nicolova (Bulgaria) Spent three days studying the instruction
and given to student nurses in the Preliminary
Miss Hinton (Gt. Britain) Training School of St. Thomas's Hospital.

Miss Kolea (Greece) Was the guest of Miss Williamson at the Royal
Infirmary, Glasgow *for one week*
During that time she was given an opportunity
of observing the work in the general surgical
ward and theatre; the gynaecological ward and
theatre; the throat and ear ward and theatre;
the dermatological ward and electrical department.
It was reported that she was very keen and thoroughly
interested in her work.

It was not considered advisable to arrange for practical work
for Miss Vitkauskaite, Miss Stencil or Miss Sharpe.

During the Michaelmas term, the students attended lectures in
Hospital Administration, Training School Administration and History of Nursing.
Visits of observation were arranged to special Hospitals and in connection with
the lectures in History of Nursing to St. John's Gate, Clerkenwell, the Wellcome
Historical Museum, and the British Museum.

During the Lent term the students will attend lectures at the College
of Nursing in Training School Administration, Educational Psychology and Methods
of Teaching, and Nutrition.
