The Secretary had further conversation with Miss Baggallay concerning the Visiting Lecturers. She now agrees that it would be better not to make any change for the present, but to continue for 3 years or so to see how the scheme works. But she thinks Miss Hutchison's lectures (Psychiatry) might be given up with advantage, because her work overlaps with that of Mr. Mace and Mrs. Folley, and the students do not really need her lectures. She will, however, speak to Mr. Mace about this before the meeting.

Therefore, unless anything further is heard from Miss Baggallay, the ordinary list for re-appointment of Visiting Lecturers to be before the Organisation Committee, less Miss Hutchison for the reasons stated above.

The Secretary showed Miss Baggallay the letter from Miss Parsons about Mrs. Halsey and Miss MacManus. Miss Baggallay said she thought Mrs. Halsey would certainly accept re-appointment. About Miss MacManus she does not know.
