Thank you for your letter of October 15th telling me that the Committee of Management of the Florence Nightingale International Foundation have resolved that, without prejudice to the future, they would agree to pay, until further notice, to Bedford College for Women, the sum of £50 per annum (being 10% of Miss Baggallay's total salary) to be allocated to her superannuation policy under the Federated Superannuation System for Universities. The situation is therefore as follows:-
