REPORT ON INTERNATIONAL NURSE ADMINISTRATOR STUDENTS.

MICHAELMAS TERM, 1931.

During the Michaelmas Term the Nurse Administrator Students attended lectures on Hospital and Training School Administration at the College of Nursing, and had written three papers on each subject. The standard of the papers had been on the whole quite satisfactory, and no marks had fallen below the pass standard.

This term the students will be attending lectures at the College of Nursing on Training School Administration, Nutrition, History of Nursing, and Educational Psychology and Methods of Teaching.

Coaching classes are being continued, the students being divided into groups of two only, as last term.

No practical work was arranged during the Christmas vacation, but the students had been to see the Queen Alexandra Military Hospital, Millbank, and Guy's Hospital, amongst other visits, and it is hoped to arrange further visits of observation for them during the coming term.
