Dear Dr. Brincker,

The Council desire me to thank you for your kind letter of May 10th and to say that, for next Session, they will be glad to meet your suggestion as to a scholarship to be offered to a student-graduate willing to qualify for a public appointment. The value of the Scholarship will be £50.

With regard to the money for this Session, provision had been made last year for the fire-place in the Hygiene Laboratory. The Council have, therefore, the sum of £50, which they will be glad to spend upon the Hygiene Museum if this object meets with your approval. They will, however, be ready to accept any other scheme of a similar character, if you would prefer it, such as, for example, books for the Hygiene Library.
