I beg to inform you that your letter of the 2nd March was before the Council of Bedford College at their meeting on Thursday last. I am directed to send to you the following resolutions which were then passed:-

- "That the offer of St. Thomas's Hospital to caary on tentatively for 2 years the scheme for the practical instruction of the Bedford College International Students in connection with their training as Public Health Workers, be accepted."
