Thank you very much for your letter of June 14th enclosing the report for the Session 1933/34. I do not think that it is necessary to go into any more detail. May I, however, suggest one or two additions for your consideration?

1. A short paragraph at the beginning stating that the Committee had carried on its work during the session on the invitation of the Provisional Committee. Would you also lay as much emphasis as possible on the collaboration with the College of Nursing? This is very important in view of the wide circulation the report will have.
2. Also a paragraph with reference to the work of the two tutors and the special value of their work. This is an important point as there salaries appear on the budget of the Provisional Committee.

I should also like to suggest that on page 2, line 24, you add after "League of Red Cross Societies" the words "acting for the Provisional Committee". The words "and other bodies" can be omitted as all applications for these Courses pass through the League.


