International Students - Special Courses.

Dr. Mess came to see me, as he had received a further application through Miss Baggallay for two additional students to attend Dr. Hatfield's lectures at King's College, instead of those provided in Psychiatry at Bedford College. Dr. Mess refuses to make these arrangements without the consent of the Committee. He takes the view that if classes are provided by Bedford College, students should attend them and not seek elsewhere for something for which they have a preference. He maintains that the case is different when Bedford College cannot provide lecturers, then he is prepared to recommend that they go elsewhere. He reports that there is a great tendency to encourage the students that they can pick and choose not only their subjects, but their lecturers in these subjects, and this he thinks is both unfair to the Department and to the College as a whole. He implied that he was not prepared to act as supervisor of a party of students who were permitted to choose their lecturers anywhere but from the College. He told me that he has told Miss Baggallay that he will not sanction any fresh arrangement unless it is done on the authority of the Committee. He stated that if it is agreed that students should go to Dr. Hatfield's lectures, then Dr. Hutchison's appointment at Bedford College should cease. He asked me to talk to the Principal about it.
