Dear Miss Jebb,

It is with very real regret that I am writing to let you know that, up to the present, we have been unable to secure the necessary funds for the continuation of the International Courses after the termination of the present session. For many months we have been trying to obtain funds, and have been in touch with the Carnegie Corporation in New York, and have been led to hope that our appeal might be successful. We telegraphed to the Corporation last week asking for a decision, but up to the moment of writing have received no reply.

In view of this I feel that the only course open to us is to make known to the Committee that we can hold out very little hope of being able to continue the courses after the termination of the present session.

I regret that situation still remains uncertain, but until the arrival of Mr. Swift who has been appointed Secretary General from February 1st, no definite decision can be taken.

May I take this opportunity to once more express to the Members of the Committee our very deep appreciation of their interest in this activity of the League which has been so successfully carried on during the past twelve years.
