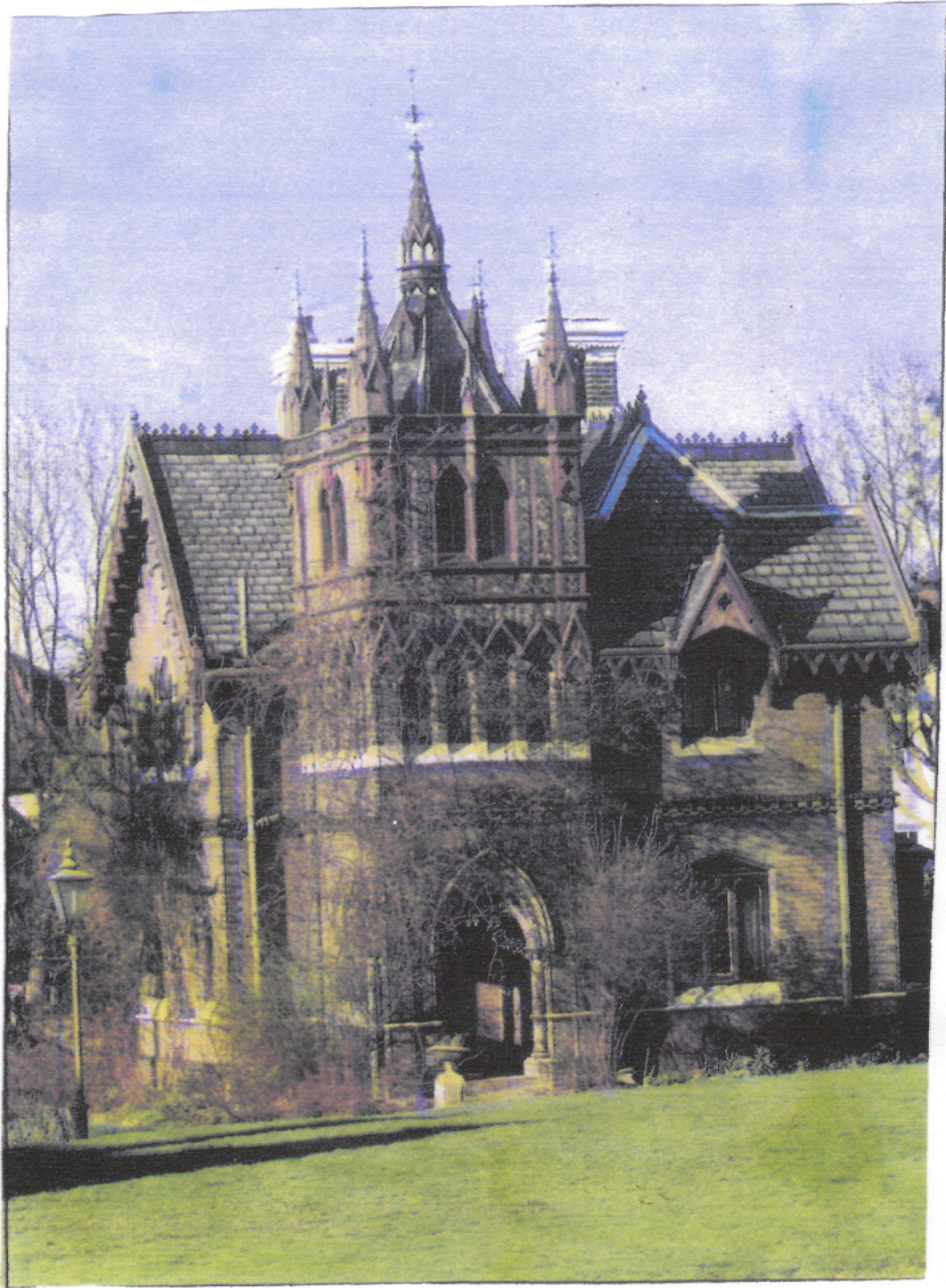

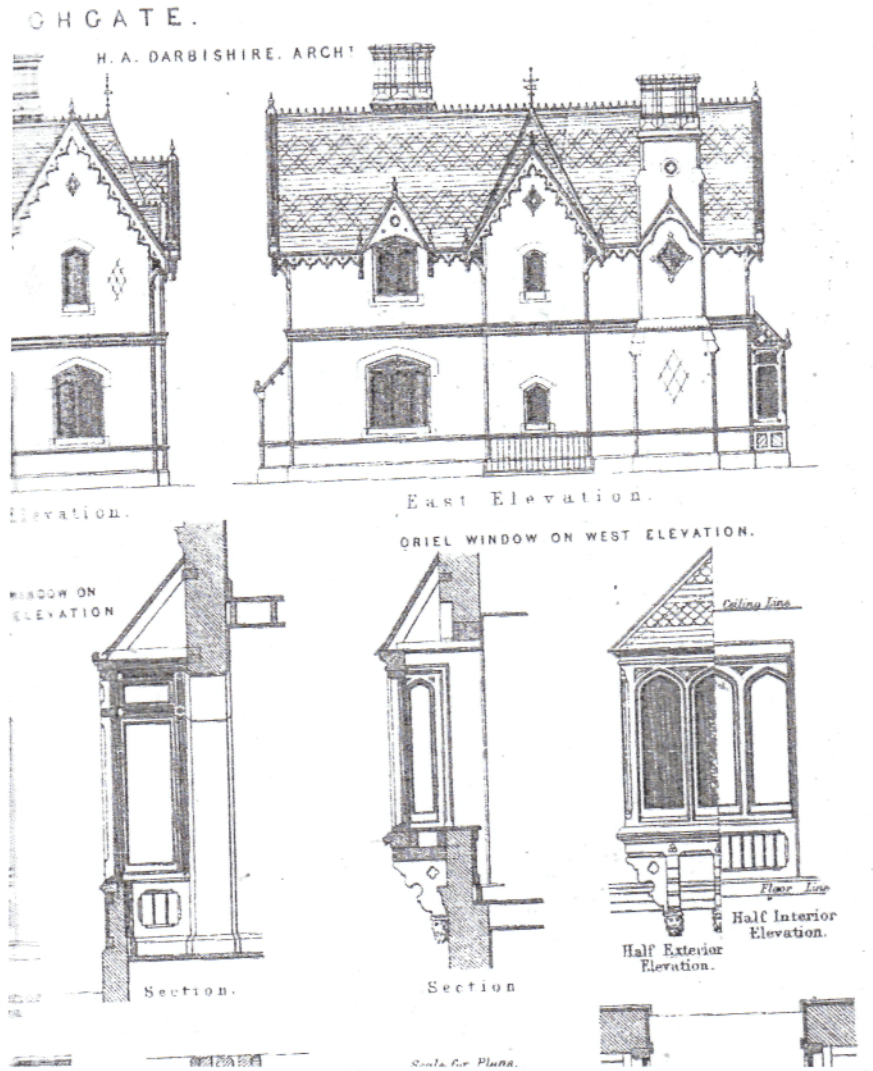

House at Holly Village, Highgate, 1869

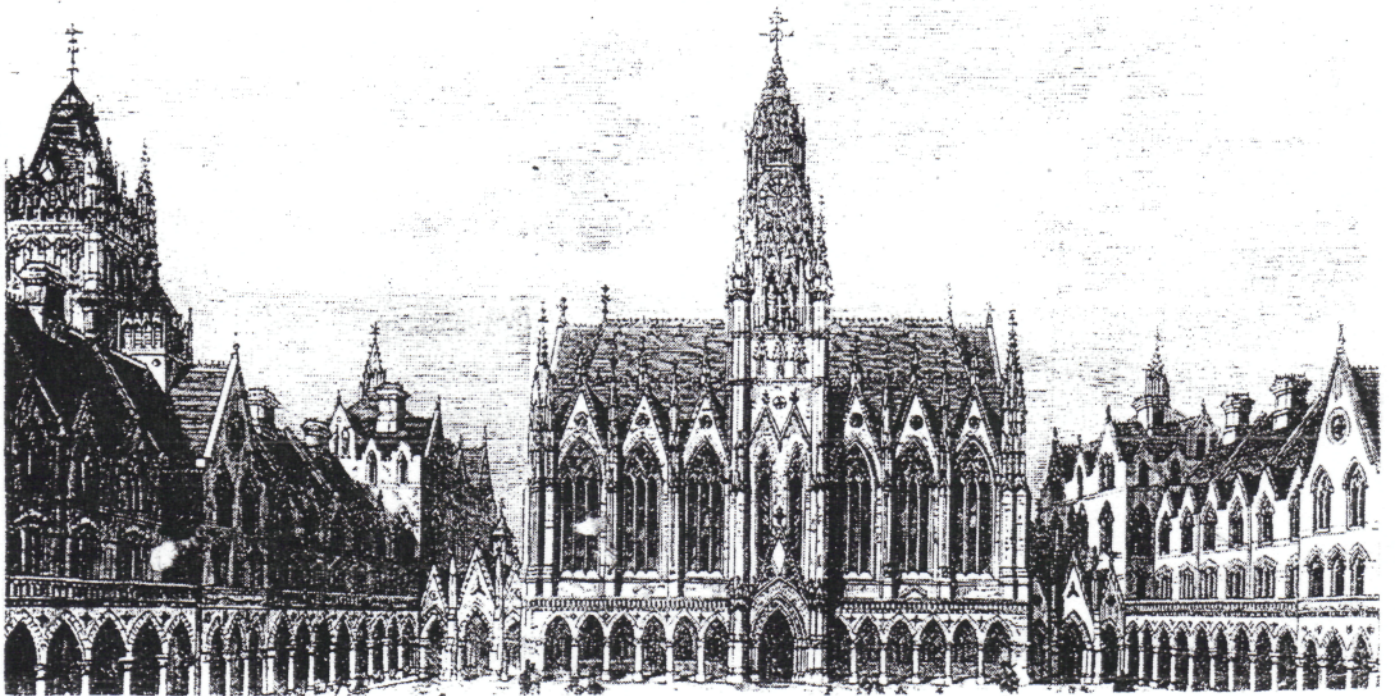

Window Details at Holly Village, Highgate, 1869.

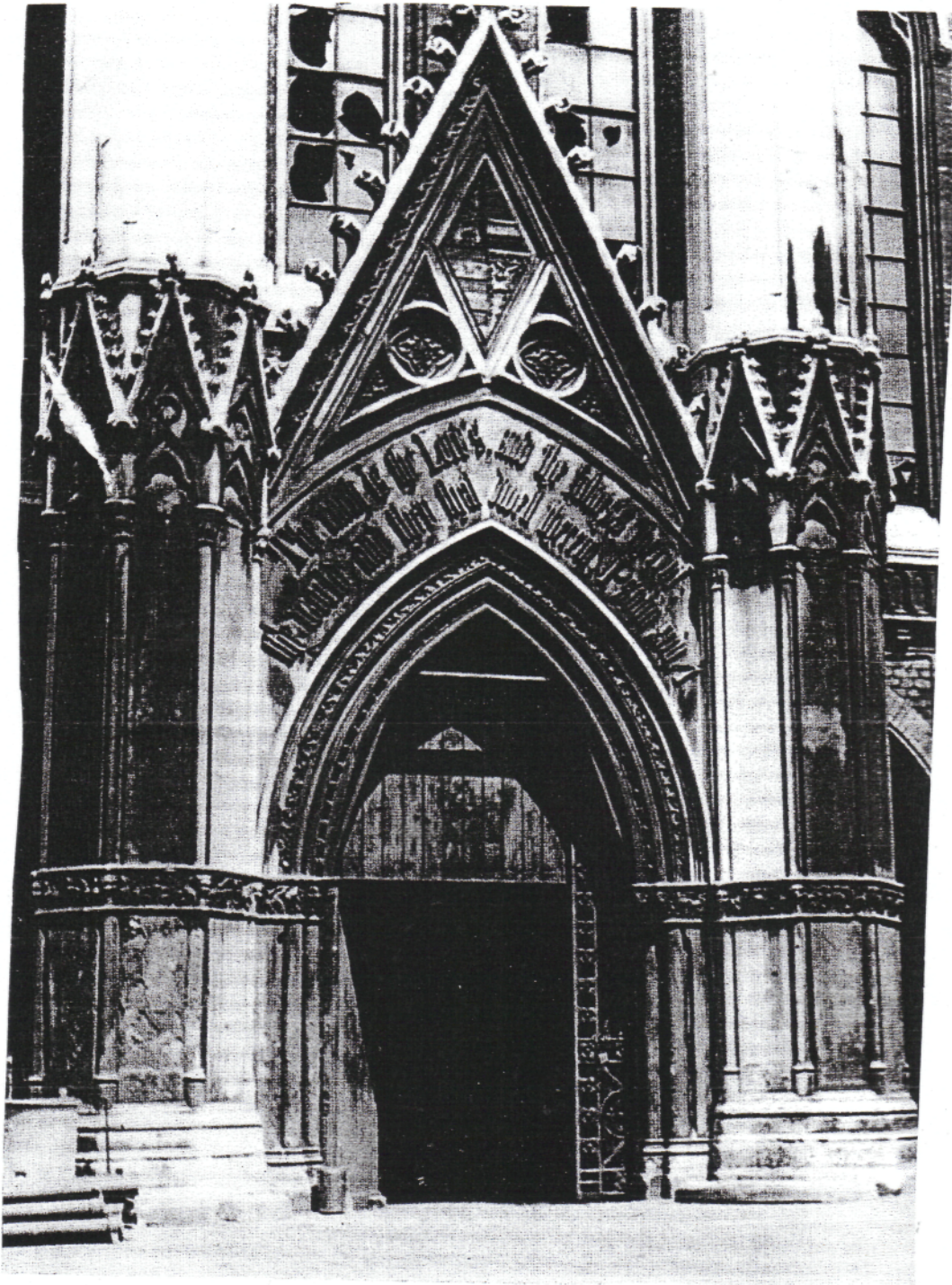

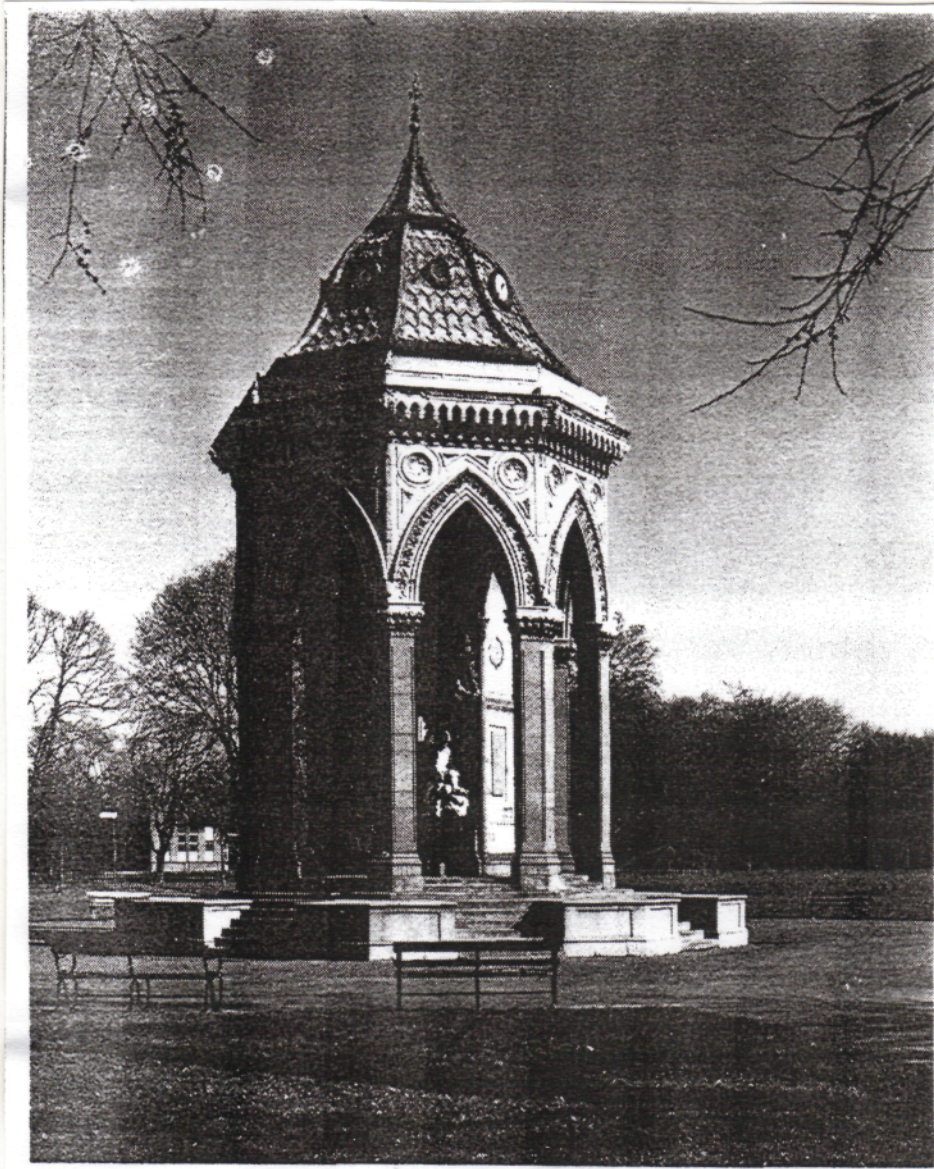
